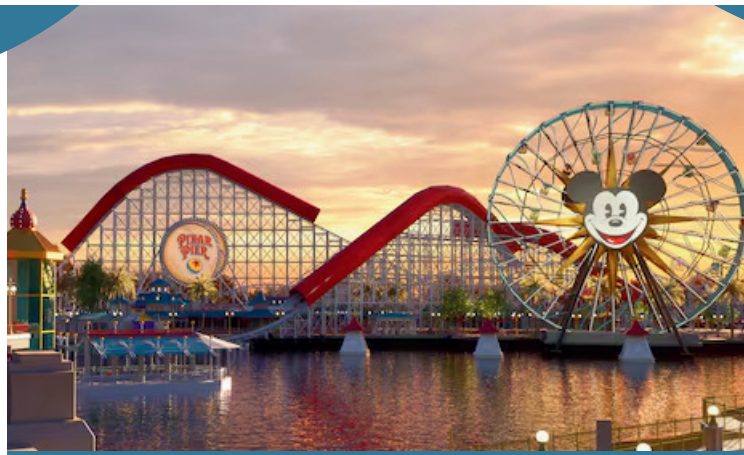

The Championship:

The MOS World Championship, presented by Certiport, Inc., is a global competition that tests students' skills in Microsoft Office applications. Top students from around the world gather to compete for the title of World Champion.

The MOS Championship Lebanon is the official national qualifier for the World Championship, organized by ITLS in strategic partnership with the Makhzoumi Foundation and academic partnership with Université La Sagesse, and under the patronage of Ministry of Education.

Participation:

To be eligible, participants must:

1. Be between **13 and 22 years old**
2. Be enrolled in an **academic institution**
3. Be **Lebanese nationals or residents**
4. Successfully pass **MOS Examination**
5. Register through **Testing Center**

Rules:

- Schools may qualify 1 student per 30 per category for the National Finals.
- Institutions with less than 30 students will have allocations based on their testing center's participation quota.
